The announcement took place during the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) Conference of the Parties (COP11) meeting.

The Registry, created by the California legislature in 2000, helps companies and organizations throughout the United States to track, publicly report and reduce their greenhouse gas emissions. The results are certified by an independent third-party to ensure compliance with Registry protocols and standardization across participants and sectors. The Registry has been internationally recognized as a gold standard for public reporting of greenhouse gases.

"By joining the California Registry, Reliant is making an impressive show of leadership on the critical environmental issue of climate change," said Diane Wittenberg, President of the California Climate Action Registry. "Moreover, early movers like Reliant gain valuable experience in measuring and managing their greenhouse gas emissions, often saving money and improving the efficiency of their operations along the way."
