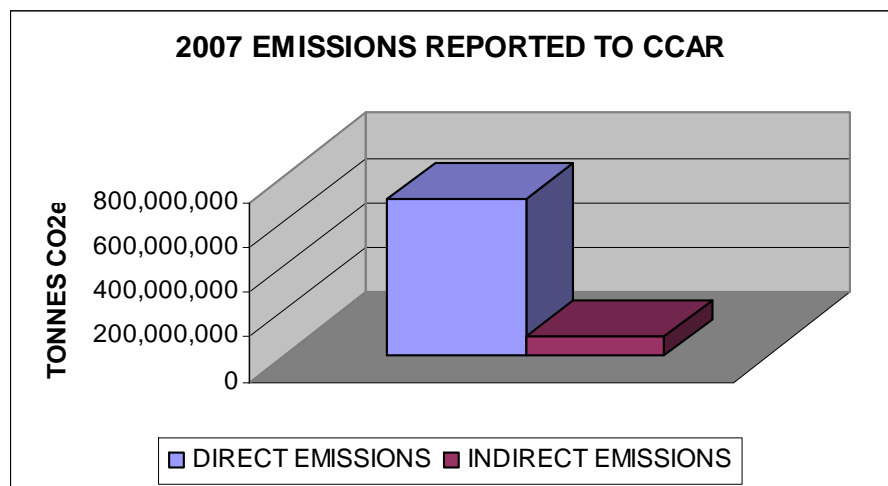

Year in Review

- 2007 Reporting Year had broadest participation to date:
 - 205 reports accepted
 - 779 mmtCO₂e reported (from 2000-2007)
- Approximately 20% show emission reductions from 2006 to 2007
 - Analysis forthcoming summer 2009

Who are CCAR Members?

- **350** members to date
 - 99% of retail power delivered in California
 - 75% of California oil refining capacity (Shell, BP, Chevron, ConocoPhillips, etc.)
 - As much as 80% of waste sector
- About half of emissions are from outside California
- You are *leaders* in your industries

Time of Change

- 2009 is a record year for climate policy development
 - California - AB 32 Implementation
 - WCI – Further Development and Definition
 - National – EPA has a draft GHG reporting rule, legislation expected this summer; federal budget relies on revenue from allowance auctions
 - International: Copenhagen expected to result in the successor agreement to the Kyoto protocol
- Achieved our Initial Legislative Mission
 - We continue to advocate on members behalf with CARB

Role of Leaders is Changing



- CCAR helped create The Climate Registry
 - Built on foundation of California program
 - 41 states + DC, all of Canada, 6 Mexican states
- As the policy debates moves to Washington, leadership moves, too

Role of Registry is Changing



- New Focus: Climate Action Reserve
- Building on our reputation for integrity, focusing on emission reduction project protocols
- Goal: ensuring environmental integrity of offsets
